

JOINT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

STONY BROOK AIR FORCE STATION (AMC)

AND

WESTOVER AIR FORCE BASE (SAC)

(This agreement based on previous agreements between Headquarters Air Materiel Command and Headquarters Strategic Air Command, when signed by the Commanders, Stony Brook Air Force Station (A MC) and Westover Air Force Base (SAC), will supersede all previous joint agreements between the two organizations.)

Part II SPECIAL WEAPONS OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

1. General

a. Special weapons operations and relative activities involve procedures calculated to provide maximum safety, security and mission accomplishment. Risks involved in such activities can be reduced to a tolerable level only thought pre-planning and agreement between all parties involved regardless of degree of participation.

b. Recognizing the safety, security and mission accomplishment risks involved, this agreement will govern all special weapons operations involving Stony Brook Air Force Station and Westover Air Force Base.

2. Responsibility

- a. Stony Brook Air Force Station will:
 - (1) Deliver necessary special weapons assemblies on roadable dollies or trailers and nuclear components to the Westover Bomb control point BCP) as required by current coordinated EWPs.
 - (2) Deliver necessary special weapons assemblies requiring straddle carrier handling to Westover Bomb control point (BCP) and thence to aircraft loading positions designated by SAC controller.


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SBAFS and WAFB Agreement (contd)

- (3) Accept at the BCP and return to Stony Brook Air Force Station any special weapons device rejected during loading or found to be surplus to SAC requirements.
- (4) Receive at the BCP and return to Stony Brook Air Force Station empty N1 or P3 weapons trailers and security covers.
- (5) Provide Nuclear Weapons Salvage Appraisal Officers and equipment as required.
- (6) Provide technical assistance and information as required.
- (7) Provide route security for convoys between the administrative gate of Stony Brook Air Force Station to hardstand number 10 at which point route security will be transferred to Westover security forces.
- (8) Provide special weapon convoy security between Stony Brook Air Force Station and the BCP, terminating such responsibility upon receipt of delivered items by SAC SW supply representative at the BCP.
- (9) Provide and man a command post on Stony Brook Air Force Station for command and communication matters during all operations.
- (10) Provide an operational control center for technical coordination with other agencies during all operations.
- (11) Provide such communications facilities as are necessary to effect coordination of above functions within the resources of Stony Brook Air Force Station.
- (12) Provide appropriately cleared Class 39D Accountable Supply Representatives for purpose of transferring custody and accountability of atomic/thermonuclear weapons and components to such agencies as may be required.
- b. Westover Air Force Base will -
 - (1) Provide normal air base facilities to include messing, housing, operations, weather briefings, foreign

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




SBAFS and WAFB Agreement (contd)

- clearances, transportation, fire-crash rescues and refueling for all AMC LSS aircraft as required.
- (2) Provide and operate with Stony Brook representation a joint Bomb Control Point facility at Westover Air Force Base to include necessary communications facilities, office forms, and equipment as required by personnel operating the Joint Weapons Control Point.
- (3) Assume physical custody, responsibility and security for all special weapons and components on roadable dollies or trailers at the BCP and assume responsibility for transportation of these weapons between the BCP and strike aircraft.
- (4) Assume accountability and security for special weapons requiring straddle carrier handling at the BCP.
- (5) Provide necessary support to include airlift and security team for Nuclear Weapons Appraisal Officers and equipment as required by applicable directives.
- (6) Allow access of Stony Brook Air Force Station personnel to Westover Air Force Base BCP and to SAC aircraft as required upon presentation of properly coded Strategic Air Command flight line badges.
- (7) Provide necessary personnel to represent appropriate SAC supply accounts to assume custody of weapons, capsules and components at Bomb Control Point. Roster of current representatives showing names, rank, serial number and clearance status will be provided Stony Brook Air Force Station prior to all operations.
- (8) Provide routing and route security for convoys between hardstand number 10 and BCP.
- (9) Provide convoy, area and route security from BCP to aircraft loading areas.
- (10) Collect and return to BCP empty N1 or P3 trailers and security covers for pick up by Stony Brook Air Force Station handling personnel.

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SBAFS and WAFB Agreement (contd)

(11) Control access of personnel in loading area and BCP to personnel cleared in accordance with AFR 205-1.

3. Changes

a. Provisions of this agreement may be changed upon mutual agreement of the Commander, Stony Brook Air Force Station and the Commander, Westover Air Force Base.
